RUTH HILTON'S memories of Central HS in 1963-64
as a Foreign Exchange Student from England.

Central Memories

Far too many to single out one. My time at Central was possibly the most influential year of my teens. Plunged into a whole new cultural, social and political environment so different from my own was a massive learning experience. All we had been told during our induction on the boat was that girls wore more make up! Nothing about social behaviour – who I was supposed to mix with out of school, no uniform unlike my English school but, dress conformity-girls didn't wear jeans, but they did wear girdles and those hideous things called Bermuda shorts – oh how fashion has changed now I have a drawer full of them but never did get used to wearing a girdle! I could neither believe nor understand that I was supposed to sit in the car passenger seat on arrival and the boy walked around to open the door for me. I was quite capable of getting out of the car, had been doing for years and this was time of emancipation for women. Covert racism and anti-semitism, a tacit racist and anti-semitic social agenda, yes it was ok to be in school with black kids but not ok to mix with them socially – other than at school functions. Jews couldn't join certain clubs and were discouraged from buying houses in some areas. This came as a real shock. Already deeply involved in the Anti-Apartheid movement at home and aware that overt racism existed in the southern states, I naively assumed that in the North equality long fought for had arrived. I had no idea of the numerous small ways in which black people were treated as second-class citizens or that Jews were separated from others in so many spheres.

I developed into a true Hoosier, abiding love of basketball now shared by my son and whenever possible we watch the NBA Pacers games together. I still treasure a bit of the sectional basketball net given to me as a memento. Was sorry not to have been on the basketball queen's court as I was on the football court in the fall, earlier in the school year.

I remember the day that Robin Weber turned up at school with his DA combed forward a la Beatles to be met with near apoplexy by the principal. He was told to go home immediately but when Robin said – Ruth told me to do it – was allowed to stay and keep the Beatle hair but just for a day.

The girls, Helene, Kathy, Gail, Jeanne, Gwen, Pam, Genelle piled into a car the size of a small ocean liner cruising the loop on South Michigan Street between Bonnie Doons and Azars. Bottles of beer left in my locker by someone who thought it was really unfair that I couldn't drink alcohol as at home the drinking age was 16. Mr. Cassidy working so hard to try and improve my very wooden acting skills in the 'The Winter' Tale as he really wanted my English accent in the play. Mr. Harter always having the time to support, explain, console and laugh with me. The patience of all the other teachers I had except the Physical Education woman – how glad was I to drop that class.

The warm, generous, hospitable welcome I was given by everyone at Central. Willingness to listen or even stop me to say something in your British accent was a bit difficult to adjust to but you guys were all so polite – even when you must have thought you were listening to the ravings of a lunatic. I am sure Beatlemania played a part in it all but you made me feel that I was just as important and valued as the four mop tops from Liverpool. A fantastic year, lessons learned about people, human behaviour and relationships that have served me well ever since. I made life long friends and have a head full of wonderful memories.
